Regular Board Meeting – USDA Service Center, 314 S. Olive, Owensville
May 3, 2010

Chairman, Ron Hardecke, called the regular board meeting to order at 8:07 p.m. Those present were: Ron Hardecke, Chairman; Curtis Koelling, Vice-Chairman; Dennis Berger, Member; Gene Rademacher, Treasurer; Andy Read, Secretary; Melinda Barch, District Conservationist; Kyle Lairmore, MDC Private Lands Conservationist; Terry DuBois, District Technician II, and Diana Mayfield, District Specialist II.

Special guests were Jerry Lairmore, Southern Commissioner; and Matt Penning, Northern Commissioner.

Prior to the opening of the official meeting, the board watched the video of the March 11 Commission meeting in order to better understand the discussion of our FY11 allocation request.

The minutes of the April meeting were read. Curtis Koelling made the motion to approve the minutes. Dennis Berger seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

The April treasurer's report and time sheets were reviewed. Beginning balance of \$17,752.35 and ending balance of \$25,585.11. Andy Read made the motion to approve the time sheets and treasurer's reports as presented. Curtis Koelling seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Unfinished Business

- ❖ Ron Hardecke and Diana Mayfield presented the board with the insurance quotes that were obtained for the rental equipment. Dennis Berger made the motion to leave the equipment insurance where it is. Curtis Koelling seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.
- ❖ Diana Mayfield reviewed the returned letters from the newsletter mailing. She indicated that the board had received 155 letters back. She has updated or removed them from the mailing list. She indicated that she received 4 back that were "temporarily away". Each returned letter cost \$.44. The next mailing will have the "or current occupant" in stead of the "return service requested."
- ❖ The discussion of next years annual meeting was revisited and it was decided to have an evening annual meeting and to see if we could get an FFA motivational speaker for the entertainment. The Board would like to shoot for the last Thursday in March, which would be March 31st in Owensville.
- ❖ The board reviewed the expenditures for the upcoming Conservation Planning Training for Terry DuBois.

New Business


- ❖ Staff reviewed the cost-share applications with the board. Curtis Koelling made a motion to accept the cost-share (listed separately) and conservation plans as presented. Dennis Berger seconded the motion.

The motion passed 4-0. Andy Read abstained from voting.

- ❖ Melinda Barch reviewed the Cooperative Conservation Partnership Initiative (CCPI) with the Board. She felt that this would be a good opportunity for the Board to request funding assistance on streambank issues. The applications need to be in the mail by May 27th, however, Diana Mayfield would be leaving for vacation on May 12 – 26, so the proposal must be completed by May 11 with Board review on that day as well. Andy Read made the motion for the district manager to attempt to draft a proposal requesting \$200,000 in the Bourbeuse Watershed, which falls south of Hwy 28. Curtis Koelling seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.
- ❖ The Board received a request from Franklin County in support of the Annual Training Conference Resolution #1 requesting the Commission to allow 10% of the cost-share funds to be flexible in each county. Dennis Berger indicated that we had presented our argument and as seen on the video, the commission had promised to address the issue, therefore, he felt that we should give them time to act. No action was taken on the Franklin County Request.
- ❖ Diana Mayfield briefed the board that AFLAC insurance was now available for Board Members and that they may retain the rate even when they leave the board. The Board was in favor of meeting with the AFLAC personnel at the next board meeting, so that they could review the rates.
- ❖ Terry DuBois had requested a new survey binder and cover. Melinda Barch indicated that she could obtain the binder but not the cover. Dennis Berger made the motion to purchase the cover. Gene Rademacher seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.
- ❖ The Board reviewed the memos and letters.
- ❖ The Board reviewed the District reports. Melinda Barch that the EQIP sign-up received 28 contracts for the FOSA with 7 being organic – 2 of the organic contracts were in Gasconade County. She indicated that she would be attending a 3 day DC conference with JR Flores in Columbia this week.
- ❖ Dennis Berger made the motion to go into closed session to discuss personnel matters as allowed by RSMo 2000; personnel actions under §610.021(3); personnel records or applications under §610.021(13). Curtis Koelling seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken. Ron Hardecke-yes, Curtis Koelling-yes, Dennis Berger-yes, Gene Rademacher-yes, and Andy Read-yes. Dennis Berger made the motion to return to open session with Curtis Koelling making a second. Ron Hardecke-yes, Curtis Koelling-yes, Dennis Berger-yes, Gene Rademacher-yes, and Andy Read-yes.
- ❖ Ron Hardecke indicated to Terry DuBois and Diana Mayfield that the Board concurred with the performance review of their appropriate supervisors.

The Board gave Diana Mayfield an "Outstanding Rating" and Terry DuBois a "Satisfactory Rating."

- ❖ The board reviewed the calendar of events.
- ❖ Ron Hardecke entertained a motion to adjourn. Andy Read so moved. Dennis Berger seconded the motion. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 10:22 p.m.
