

Woodland Erosion

County maximum of \$6,000.00 per year/per landowner.

DFR-5, Woodland Protection Through Livestock Exclusion

Fencing out woodlands and riparian corridors that have a minimum of 10% slope or meet the erosion factor. Maintenance Agreement – 10 years.

N472, Use Exclusion (Incentive)

Fencing out woodlands and riparian corridors with a one-time incentive of \$5.00 per acre for the area to be excluded. Maintenance Agreement – 10 years

C100, Timber Harvest Management

Financial assistance for the proper design and implementation of best management practices. This is an incentive payment for 20-75 acres at \$20/acre and 75+ acres at \$1500 plus \$15/acre for every acre over 75. Fields that have been harvested in the last 5 years are not eligible unless multiple harvests are recommended by the technical forester. Maintenance Agreement – 10 years.

N655, Restoration of skid trails, logging roads, stream crossings and log landings

Treatment of gully erosion caused in the above mentioned areas. Maximum cost-share per treatment area is \$1,500 or 75% of the state average cost. Maintenance Agreement – 10 years.
