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## Executive Order 12-08 Acknowledgement Form

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (print landowner's name) acknowledge that upon application for drought assistance according to Executive Order 12-08, the conditions on my property meet these three criteria outlined in the executive order:

1. I am engaged in livestock or crop production and currently experiencing a water shortage caused directly by the current drought conditions;
2. The water shortage being experienced on my property is severely impacting the well-being of my livestock or crop production; and
3. The proposed water source development or water distribution practice will produce an **immediate material benefit** to the well-being of my livestock or crop production.

To be eligible for livestock drought assistance, the farm must be experiencing a rapid decline in livestock water supply affecting the ability for the landowner to retain livestock. Furthermore, I acknowledge that my practice(s) may be inspected by the state for compliance with Executive Order 12-08, and I certify that I will not start my practice(s) until the drought assistance contract is board approved.
