FISCAL YEAR 2014 COST-SHARE ALLOCATION

(July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014)

Holt SWCD has been allocated funds for FY14 in the following resource concerns:

Sheet, Rill & Gully – **\$376,947***

Nutrient – **\$6,400**

Irrigation - **\$12,000**

*\$107,108.37 was obligated for Spring & Summer projects. **\$269,838.63 remains for Fall**

NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT

N590 Nutrient Management –Cost-share incentive payment is up to \$20.00 per acre with a lifetime practice maximum of \$10,000 for contracts approved between January 1 and April 15, 2014. Continuous Sign Up. Please contact our office for further information.

IRRIGATION

N442 Irrigation System, Sprinkler – Cost-share is authorized for replacement of existing sprinklers or nozzles with those that increase system efficiency, limited to 75% of the state average cost and four pivots per cooperators and/or farm. Continuous Sign Up. Please contact our office for further information.

NO-TILL SYSTEM

DSL-15 No-Till System –Cost-share incentive payment is up to \$15.00 per acre (40 acres/\$600 maximum). Authorized to reduce erosion or runoff pollution. Not authorized for producers who have utilized a no-till system. Continuous Sign Up. Please contact our office for further information.

The **Cost-Share Program** is a state funded program which provides financial incentives to landowners for installing erosion reduction practices. This funding comes from the 1/10th of 1% parks, soils and water sales tax.

FALL COST-SHARE ASSISTANCE

-NO SIGN-UP – The process is as follows:

-The **COOPERATOR** advises our office after the Crop has been harvested.

-Our office schedules an on-site planning visit (within 2 weeks) with cooperators AND contractor.

-Our technician will assist the contractor to **begin** the survey as agreed upon during planning. (Ex: Terrace 1 of the series)

-The **contractor will complete the survey** and submit to our office. *Incomplete survey notes will be returned to the contractor.*

-Our technician will GPS/Trimble within 5 days of submission of survey notes.

-Survey notes will be designed in date order based upon the date the contractor's completed survey was submitted to our office.

-Upon completion of the design and submission of ALL required forms (authorization, vendor, landowner agreements), a Pre-Construction Conference (PCC) will be held with the **cooperator, earthmoving AND tiling contractors.**

-Designs will be released after the PCC but not until contracts have been board approved.

-Within approximately 2 weeks of receipt of contractor checkout notes, all practices will be checked in the field by NRCS. *Technicians will not create an 'as-built' design in lieu of the contractor constructing the project as originally designed.

****Projected timeframes are subject to workload, weather, and staff availability.**
