LL&W is teaming up with the US Army Corps of Engineers to offer trainings on the use of their river curriculum *Our Mississippi*. This education guide was created to help teachers inform future decision-makers about the importance of the Mississippi River (as well as the Illinois and Ohio Rivers) as a natural resource. The guide follows multi-disciplinary curriculum, intermixing science,

technology, and math with social science, language and arts to help aid educators in introducing the multifaceted, resource management issues that exist on the river.
