Tom Kremer, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m.

**Correspondence:** None

**Minutes:** Tom Kremer questioned how the Closed Session was worded. Jim Kleinsorge made a motion to approve the minutes with the wording correction of Closed Session from the November 14, 2012 board meeting, seconded by Gene Eldringhoff. Motion carried unanimously.

Jim Kleinsorge would like to include Gasconade County when having meetings. Tammy Teeter stated that we send information to adjoining counties. He also stated that he thanked Ann Whitehead for the meeting reminders the day before the meeting. It was suggested that we contact each board member to remind them of the meetings.

**Treasurer Report:** Brenda Van Booven reviewed Treasurer Report for the month. After discussion, Jim Kleinsorge made a motion to approve Treasurer's Report as presented, seconded by Gene Eldringhoff. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Kremer reviewed and signed the district timesheets.

There was a discussion on equipment and the condition of the 7' drill, Bob Ridgley reported that the trade-in value of the 7' drill is between \$8,000-\$8,500. Bob Ridgley did not recommend trading the 7' drill at this time.

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Brenda Van Booven presented the board with CD rates from Peoples Savings Bank and Martinsburg Bank and Trust. After review and discussion, Gene Eldringhoff moved to renew CD #10 for \$12,354.60 with Peoples Savings Bank for a 48 month term and a rate of 1.25%, seconded by Jim Kleinsorge. Motion carried unanimously.

**Missouri State Cost-Share:** Karen Sinclair handed out the State Cost-Share reports and reviewed the balances in each resource concern. Tammy reported John James is going ahead and scheduling for the advanced allocation of FY13 funds. Bob Ridgley passed out a copy of the letter to send to the next 20 landowners on the cost-share list. The board discussed the 18% advanced allocation that was mentioned at the Commission meeting. Tammy Teeter noted the need to get with Darrell Campbell concerning the approval of the Streambank designs Ann Whitehead had worked on.

**Conservation Plans:** Jim Kleinsorge moved to approve the conservation plans as presented, seconded by Gene Eldringhoff. Motion carried unanimously.

**Machinery Report:** Gene Eldringhoff moved to accept the machinery report as presented, seconded by Jim Kleinsorge. Motion carried with unanimous vote.

**Travel & Training Report:** Staff reported "From the Ground Up" was the theme at the Soil and Water Conservation Districts Annual Training Conference November 25- November 28, 2012 at Tan-Tar-A. They attended a workshop "The Plan for the Future for the Soil and Water Conservation Program". It is a vision for how we protect and preserve our soil and water resources on agricultural land for future generations for Missouri. The program office is making a special effort to gather input from all over the state as we all have a vested interest in the development of the plan to ensure continued stewardship supported by the Parks, Soils and Water Sales Tax. The brainstorming session was to generate ideas on how to balance staffing

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throughout the state to maximize implementation of soil and water conservation practices. Other workshop topics ranged from Grassland Recovery, Pond Cleanout/ Reconstruction, Soil Health, District Supervisor Elections, Conflict of Interest/Nepotism, Payroll & Taxes, to Financial Reports and Minutes, NRCS Field Office of the Future. Those attending were Harry Cope, Bob Ridgley, Ann Whitehead and Brenda Van Booven.

**AgNPS Report:** Ann Whitehead stated that she had contacted Angela Belden concerning the tree plans for the Streambank projects on Brian Houska and Wayne Overkamp.

Grazing Meeting with Mark Kennedy is scheduled for January 24.

Ann Whitehead reported she is waiting on Van Booven Trust to decide as to what conservation practices they want to do. She is working on grazing system on John Abbott's. The Grazing System includes waterlines and fence designs and she will get with John James to approve pipeline.

Harry Cope is speaking at the Livestock Symposium in Kirksville this weekend.

**District Report:** Brenda Van Booven handed out the minutes from the two staff meetings held this month. Tom Kremer would like to see the staff pie charts on the time summary from each staff member. Discussion on staffing which included talk about staking for individual landowners to construct conservation practices on their own.

Harry Cope joined in on the speakerphone. He reported that he met with Colleen Meredith, Jim Boschert, and Ralph Glosemeyer. The Program Office agreed to a position that would split an employee 3 days in Montgomery County and 2 days in Warren County. The Technician I position would be funded at \$10.59 and funds are available for this position. The position would be full-time for one year and be reviewed on a yearly basis. The employee would be housed at whatever location is closest and could use a federal vehicle if available, if not mileage would be available. The open position would need to be advertised in both counties and interview with both counties but first the job duties need to be determined. Warren County board meeting is December 20<sup>th</sup>. Tom Kremer will get with Ralph Glosemeyer, Warren County Board Chairman, on the position. Karen stated she is interested in a full-time position. Tom will talk with Ralph about setting up a committee. It was stated that someone is needed to coordinate duties. Tammy Teeter stated that she is the work coordinator for field work.

Harry Cope also mentioned that one county is using a college student to do their information/education program for \$600.

**NRCS Report:** Tammy Teeter reported the office is getting a video television. This will allow us to participate in meetings without the travel. We will be one of the training sights in the area.

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Conservation Compliance and Program Updates is the topic of the meetings on January 3. There are two sessions scheduled first at 2:00 at the Montgomery City Lions Building and the second at 6:30 p.m. at the Warren County Extension Center.

It was mentioned that staff would like to do something on Cover Crops this winter.

NRCS Chief Dave White announced he will be stepping down and Jason Weller takes on the role of Acting Chief.

John James and Bob Ridgley are going to talk to County Committee in David Korman's absence.

New signup for CSP and EQIP will start soon. Tammy Teeter stated that they have not received the details.

**Old Business:** Nomination Committee Brenda Van Booven passed out "Duties of the nominating Committee" and list of potential candidates. Brenda Van Booven stated that Tammy Bruckerhoff was the only person that responded with interest in serving on the committee. Brenda Van Booven will contact suggested landowners in Area I and Gene Eldringhoff will get a list for Area III. Brenda Van Booven stated the committee would need to meet and report at the January board meeting who the two or more candidates in each territory would be and check the eligibility of these candidates. Election will be at the Open House in March. Brenda Van Booven will check on the date of National Ag Day, which is usually when we hold the Open House.


