JD Hutsell has been a member of the Wright County Soil and Water Conservation District board of supervisors since 1966. During this time he has also been a full time dairyman and served as Wright County Clerk. He has served as the Missouri Association of Soil and Water Conservation Districts Area Director and has been the SWCD board chairman for many years. Under JD's leadership the Wright County SWCD has developed an extensive equipment rental program that is envied by landowners and Districts across the state. The equipment includes 4 no-till drills, 1 warm season grass drill, 6 sprayers, burn equipment, field roller, flex harrow and 2 sets of lagoon pumping equipment as well as various other pieces of rental equipment. The Soil and Water district has had many successful special area projects and currently has 2 active special projects. JD has always been ready to take on new challenges in an effort to help the landowners in the county meet their conservation objectives. The Wright County SWCD would not be nearly as successful as it is today without JD's years of service and leadership.
